Toward the end of each semester, we hold our own opening of the 'McConnell Gallery' here at school as part of McConnell Fine Arts Night. Students and family will be invited to view artwork from both art class and the school art club. Art students will receive an extra credit grade for attending! Date will be announced.

Conduct & Effort

Students are expected to follow all school rules and policies, as well as being ready and respectful each day when entering art class. Some sections of class will involve moving around the room and working with various materials, and so it is especially important to maintain respectful, mature, and safe behavior at all times. Student behavior will be documented (both negative and exemplary) throughout the term and the student will receive a mark on both conduct and effort at the end of the course.

First offense------warning
Second offense----isolation and student teacher conference
Third offense----agenda signature, notify parent
Fourth offense----detention
Fifth offense-----administrative referral

Although students may have varying levels of artistic skill, students are expected to show their best effort on all assignments. Student effort will be graded on their use of time, ability to follow instructions, and their willingness to assume responsibility for their own work.
